<b>Format of Event</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tournament format will be single elimination with a consolation bracket for the first round losers. Quarterfinal losers will compete for 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> places. Subject to change based on smaller draw sizes.</li> <li>The NSGA and LOC reserve the right to change the tournament format for any age division based on entry numbers, space restrictions, or other circumstance. Game start times are subject to change if ahead of schedule.</li> </ol>				
<b>Rules</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All matches will be conducted in accordance with United States Tennis Association (USTA) rules, except as modified herein. For a copy of these rules, please write or call:  <p style="text-align: center;">United States Tennis Association Publications Department 70 West Red Oak Lane, White Plains, NY 10604 (914) 696-7000 <a href="http://www.usta.com">www.usta.com</a></p> </li> <li>If an athlete is entered in more than one tennis event, a situation may arise wherein he/she will have to play more than the USTA-recommended number of matches in any given day. Attempts will be made to schedule in such a manner to avoid conflicts between events. However, it is the responsibility of the athlete to make conflicts known to the Competition Manager with sufficient time in order to reschedule or withdraw.</li> <li>The scoring format for all singles and doubles matches will be two out of three tiebreak sets, in the event of sets, a match tiebreak (first to 10 points win by 2) will be played. There will be no full third sets. The only exception to this is that it may be modified in accordance with Format, Item 3.</li> </ol>				
<b>Awards</b>	Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals will be given for Men's, Women's, and Mixed Divisions in each age category (50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75-79; 80-84; 85-89; 90-94; 95-99; 100+). All medal winners will be recognized immediately following competition.				



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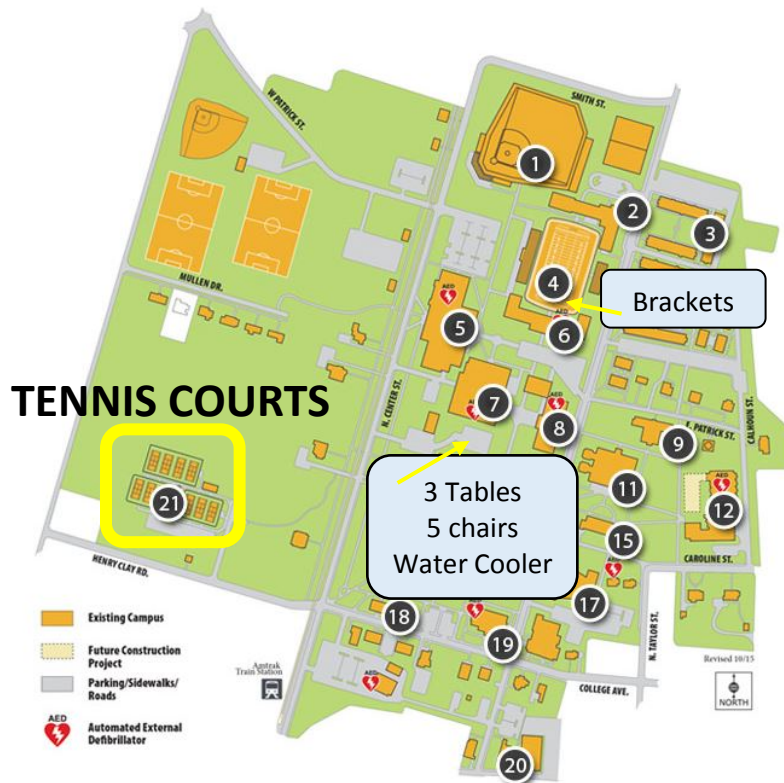


## Entry Regulations

1. Athletes may compete with only one partner per event. Under NSGA rules, doubles and mixed doubles are classified as events. Therefore, athletes may not compete in more than one age division for doubles or mixed doubles.
2. The age division of competition for doubles will be determined by the lower age of the two partners as of December 31, 2018.
3. Athletes must provide their own racquets and practice balls.
4. Athletes may enter a maximum of two tennis events.

The Virginia Senior Games are considered “open” games, meaning participants from other states are permitted and encouraged to compete in the Virginia Senior Games. The Senior Games strongly recommends that each participant consult his or her physician in regard to practice and participation in this program or any similar physical activity program.
